

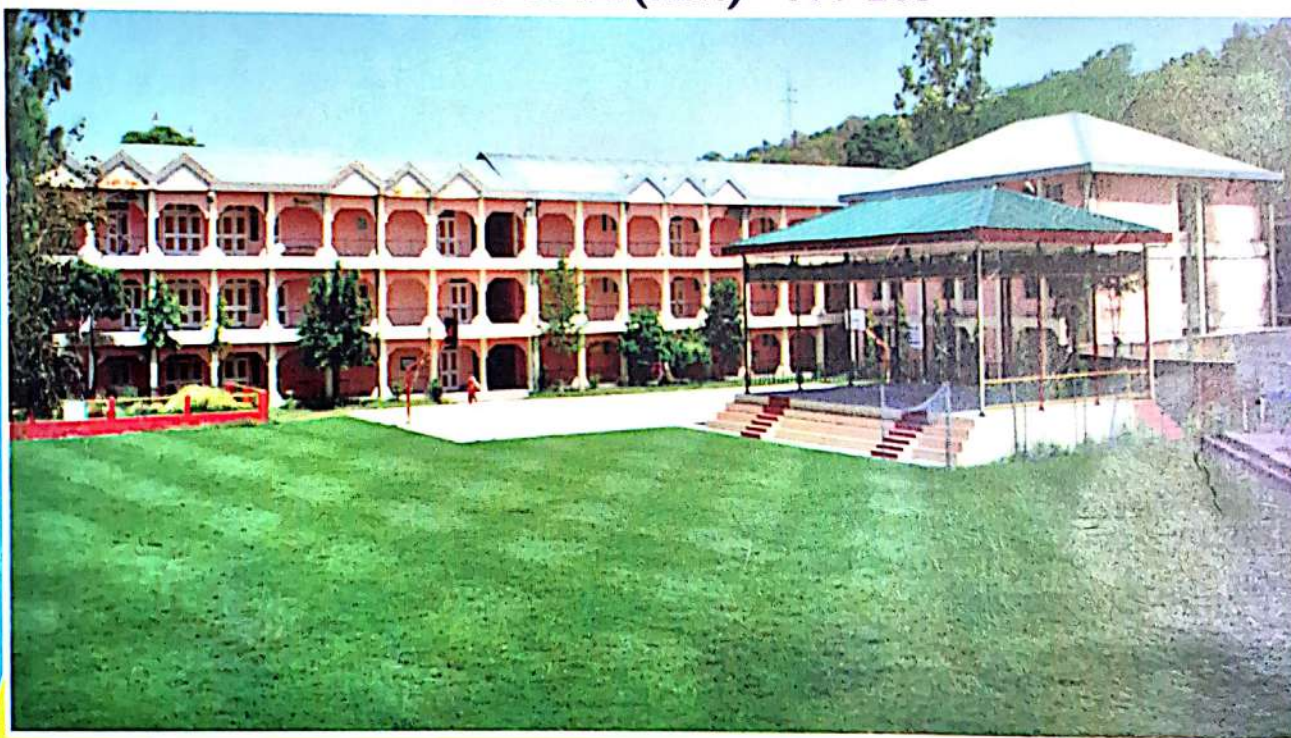

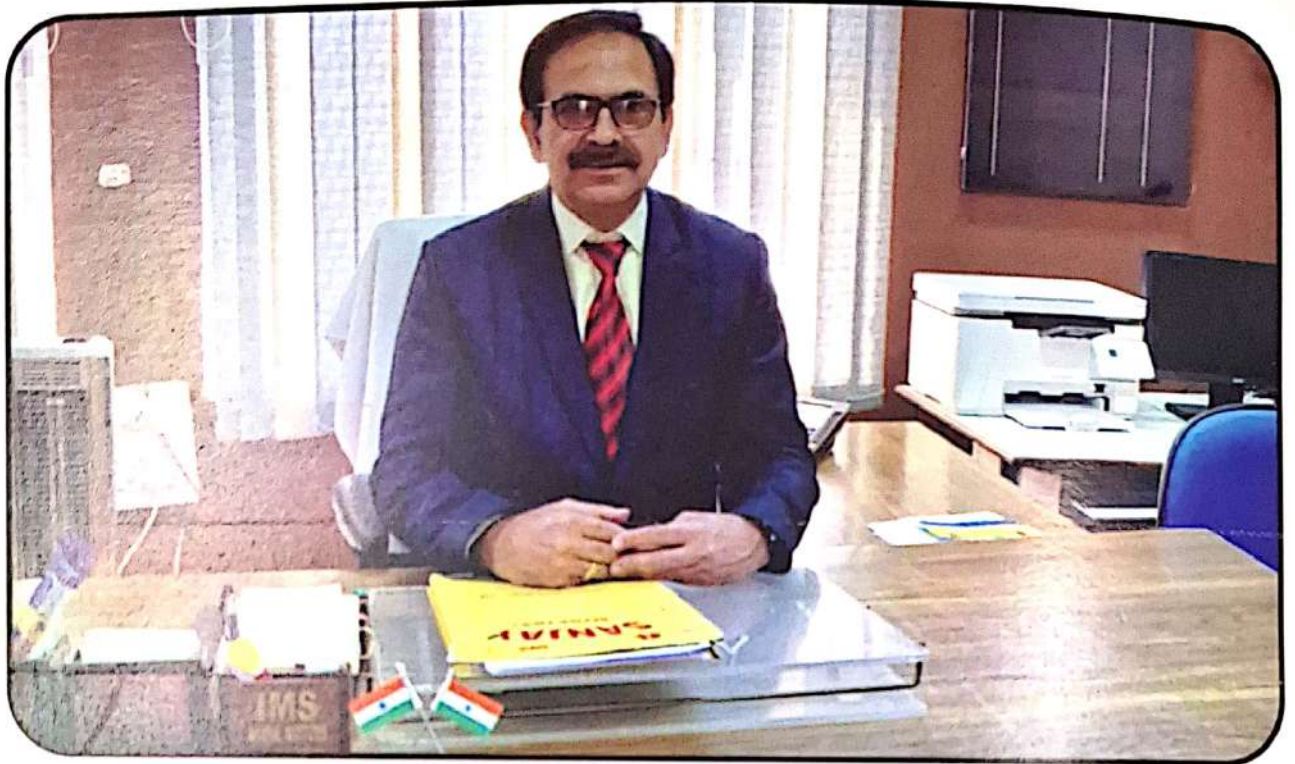

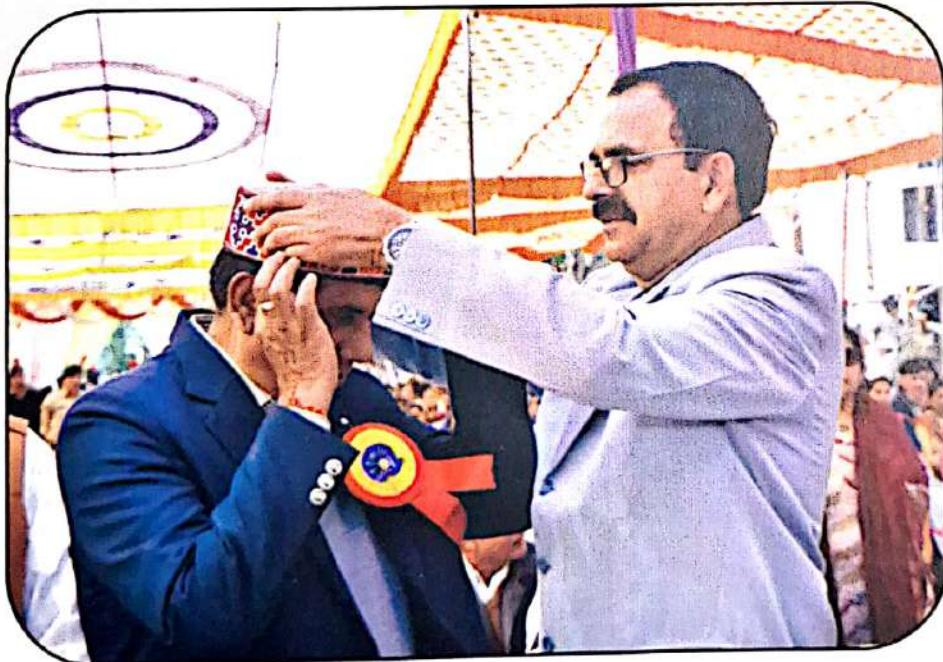

Nanotoxicology In The Enviroment

Nanotoxicology mainly deals with the toxicity of nanomaterials/ nanoparticles. The main aim of nanotoxicological studies is to determine the toxic /hazardous effects of nanoparticles and nanopharmaceuticals on human and enviroment. Typical nanoparticles that have been widely studied in different toxicological studies are silver (Ag - NPs) , gold (Au - NPs),

titanium dioxide (TiO_2 - NPs), Cesium dioxide, iron oxide, alumina, zinc (ZnO - NPs), Carbon black (CB), and diesel exhausted nanoparticles, as well as carbon nanotubes, fullerenes and "nano C60"(Khalili Fard et al 2015; Azhdarzadeh et al. ,2015)

Because of quantum size effects and large surface area to volume ratio, nanomaterials have unique properties, compared with their larger counterparts. The toxicity of nanoparticles may not be seen with larger particles that consist of the same material or element. Nanomaterials, even made of inert elements (Such as gold) can become highly active at the nanometer dimensions (Khalili Fard et al. ,2015; Azhdarzadeh et al. 2015)

In the last decade, scientists who work in the field of nanotoxicology, are demanding tighter regulations of nanotechnology products as safety of these products is being questioned after nanomaterials showed high toxicity, particularly in inhalation studies.

Role of Economics in Political Life

Political economy is the study of production and trade and their relations with law, custom and government and with the distribution of national income and wealth. Political economy originated in moral philosophy in the 18th century to explore the administration of states wealth with "Political" signifying the greek word "polity" and "economy" signifying the greek word "Okonomic". The earliest works of political economy are usually attributed to the British scholars Adam Smith, Thomas Malthus and David Ricardo, although they were preceded by the work of the French Physiocrats, such as Francois Quesnay (1694-1774) and Anne-Robert Jacques Turgot (1727-1781)

Economics is concerned with studying and influencing the economy. Political is the theory and practice of influencing people through the exercise of power, e.g. government elections and political parties. In theory, economics could be non-political. Elected politicians could then weigh up this economic information and decide.

Economics needs Political Support :-If you study economics you can make quite a convincing case for apigovian tax-a tax which makes people pay the full social cost of the good, and not just the private cost. The principle of making the polluter pay provides a case for carbon Tax, congestion charges, alcohol tax, and tobacco tax etc. However, whether there politics get implemented depends on weather there is political support for them. For e.g. a congestion charge was proposed formanchester, but it was very heavily defeated in referendum. A new tax is rarely popular. As an economist, I would like to see more congestion charging because it makes economic sense, But what can make 'sense' to an economist can be politically unpopular.

Amartya Sen

Amartya Sen, (Born Number 3,1933, Santiniketan, India) was the first Indian to receive Nobel Prize in Economics. Amartya sen received the Nobel Prize in economics sciences in 1998 for his contribution to welfare economics and social choice theory and for his interest in the problems of society's poorest members. Sen was best known for his work on the causes of famine, which led to the development of practical solutions for preventing

or limiting the effects of real or perceived shortages of food.

Sen was educated at Presidency College in Calcutta. He went on to study at Trinity College, Cambridge, where he received a B.A. (1955), an M.A. (1959) and a Ph.D. (1959). He taught economics at a number of universities in India and England, including the universities of Jadavpur (1956-58) and Delhi (1963-71), the London School of Economics, the University of London (1971-77), and the University of Oxford (1977-88), before moving to Harvard University (1988-98) when he was professor of Economics and Philosophy. In 1998 he was appointed Master of Trinity College, Cambridge, a position he held until 2004, when he returned to Harvard as Lamont University Professor.

Welfare Economics :- Seeks to evaluate economic policies in terms of their effects on the well-being of the community. Sen, who devoted his career to such issues, was called the "conscience of his profession". His influential monograph *Collective Choice and Social Welfare* (1970) which addressed problems such as individual rights, majority rule, and the availability of information about individual conditions inspired researchers to turn their attention to issues of basic welfare. Sen devised methods of measuring poverty which yielded useful information for improving economic conditions for the poor. For instance, his theoretical work on inequality provided an explanation, for why there are fewer women than men in some poor countries in spite of the fact that more women than men are born and infant mortality is higher among males. Sen claimed that this skewed ratio results from the better health treatment and childhood opportunities afforded to boys in those countries.

The Bal Swachhta Mission is a part of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.

6. Skill India : July 16, 2015

Main objective :

Train over 40 crore people in India in different skills by 2022. The main goal of skill India Programme is to create opportunities, space and scope for the development of talents of the Indian Youth.

7. Udaan Scheme : November 14, 2014

National Anti Profiteering Authority Powers & Online Complaint Facility

The National Anti-Profiteering Authority (NAA) was established under section 171 of the Central Goods and Service Tax Act 2017. The NAA was set up to monitor and to oversee whether the reduction or benefit of input tax credit is reaching the recipient by way of appropriate reduction in prices. National Anti- profiteering Authority (NAA) is therefore primarily constituted by the central government to analyse whether input tax credit availed by any registered person or the reductions in the tax is protected from random price increase for self interests in the name of GST. The National Anti- profiteering Authority comprises of a life member committee consisting of a chairman, four technical members. The Additional Director General of safeguards under the Central Board of indirect taxes and customs (CBEC) would be the secretary to NAA. The National Anti- profiteering Authority Committee will initially have a two year tenure that can be extended by the GST council if they see a requirement for its existence in future. The primary aim of the National profiteering Authority is to ensure the benefits of reduction or lower taxes under New GST regime are passed on to the end consumers. When is to determined that if any reduction in the rate of tax on Supply of goods or service is passed onto the final recipient by way of proportional reduction in price.

- Monetary Policy**: Process by which the Central Bank in a country controls the supply of money. RBI is Central Bank of India.
- Repo Rate** : Re purchase Option : Rate at which the RBI gives loans to other banks for short period.
- Reverse REPO Rate** : Rate at which the RBI borrow loans to from other Banks.
- CRR** : (Cash Reserve Rate) : The percentage of liquid cash every bank has to keep with the RBI. It is percentage of their deposits.
- SLR** : (Statutory liquidity Ratio) : The percentage of liquid cash reserve bank has to keep with themselves.
- Fiscal Policy** : The policy of a govt. by which it adjust tax rates and spending levels in order to influence the national economy.
- Balance of Payments** : It is difference in total value between payment into and out of a country over a period.
- Tariff** : It is tax imposed on imported goods and service. So tariffs make imported goods costlier.
- Capital** : It is sum of money invested in a business to generate profit. Though there are many more terms but these are few basic terms to understand economics.

This college was started in 1970 as National College Amb by Late Sh. Hans Raj Akrot, a prominent citizen of this area to provide Higher Education to the students of this area. It was taken over by Govt. in 1997 and renamed as Maharana Pratap Govt. College, Amb with about 400 students in Arts & Science (Non-Medical). In 2016 NAAC awarded grade B to this Institution with CGPA 2.4. The present set up of college is a result of persistent efforts of staff & students and regular support from the people of the area and the Government.

Now the college offers undergraduate courses in Arts, Science, Commerce and Post Graduate courses in English and Commerce. We have BCA and BBA courses under Self-Finance scheme. This project is designed for the youth of Himachal Pradesh, to make them competent for service industry. The students are trained by the highly Industry Professional Trainers. After completion of the course the students will get opportunity of the jobs in the college campus itself.
