## 7. Cleanliness Drive

During this initiative, the cadets diligently undertook the task of cleaning not only the college campus but also the surrounding areas, exhibiting a commendable commitment to maintaining a hygienic environment.

As part of their community outreach, the NCC cadets proactively engaged with fellow students, emphasizing the significance of cleanliness in our daily lives. They conveyed the critical message that a clean environment is essential for overall well-being, as unclean surroundings can potentially harbor diseases that pose significant health risks. By enlightening their peers on the importance of cleanliness, the cadets sought to cultivate a collective responsibility for maintaining a sanitary and healthy atmosphere. Further



amplifying their commitment to the cause, the cadets organized a spirited rally around the college campus. During this rally, they vociferously raised slogans advocating for a clean village, clean district, clean state, and clean country. This dynamic expression of their

## **8. Enrolment Process**

The initiation of the enrolment process for new NCC cadets at Maharana Pratap Government Degree College in AMB marked the availability of 22 vacancies, comprising 14 for Senior Division (SD) and 8 for Senior Wing (SW) on 15<sup>th</sup> of September, 2022. A substantial response was witnessed, with over 250 applications received.

To ensure the selection of ideal candidates for both SD and SW positions, the enrolment procedure was systematically divided into four distinct phases:

### **1<sup>st</sup> Phase (Pre-Physical):**

During this initial phase, a comprehensive assessment was conducted, encompassing parameters such as height, weight, eyesight, and the examination of factors like flat feet.

### **2<sup>nd</sup> Phase (Written Test):**

A written examination was administered by the NCC unit, featuring questions spanning general awareness, mathematics, NCC-related topics, and current affairs. This phase served as a crucial evaluation of the candidates' cognitive abilities and knowledge base.

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Phase (Physical Test):**

A two-part physical test was conducted:

**Running:** Boys were required to cover a distance of 1600 meters, while girls had a stipulated distance of 800 meters.

**Strength Assessment:** Included elements like push-ups and pull-ups, gauging the candidates' physical fitness and endurance.

### **4<sup>th</sup> Phase (Interview):**

Following successful completion of the initial three phases, candidates proceeded to the interview stage, where they interacted with the Commanding Officer (CO) for a final assessment.



Upon successful navigation through these comprehensive phases, selected candidates were formally inducted into the NCC, marking the completion of the enrollment process. This systematic and multi-faceted approach ensured a rigorous evaluation of candidates, aligning with the commitment to recruiting well-rounded and dedicated individuals to contribute to the NCC program at Maharana Pratap Government Degree College.



### **9. National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) hands on training cum workshop**

A delegation from the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) visited Maharana Pratap Government Degree College in AMB on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2022, with the primary objective of imparting crucial insights into Disaster Management, particularly focusing on enlightening the student body and, in particular, the NCC cadets.

The National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), operating under the Ministry of Home Affairs, stands as a specialized unit within the Indian Armed Forces, dedicated to disaster response. As a multi-disciplinary and multi-agency organization, the NDRF plays a pivotal role in addressing and mitigating the impact of various disasters.

During the session, the NDRF team emphasized the significance of equipping students, including NCC cadets, with the knowledge and skills required to safeguard lives both during and after a disaster. They elucidated practical strategies on how individuals can effectively contribute to their safety and that of others in the face of unforeseen calamities.

The discourse extended to proactive measures for disaster preparedness, whereby students were educated on the importance of pre-disaster planning. 
